Aids and Adaptations

**Do you require help to enable
you to continue to live
independently in your own
home?**

At some stage in your life you may need additional support so that you can continue to live independently in your own home. Improvements to your home that may be useful include:-

- **ramps for wheelchair users,**
- **replacing your bath with a shower,**
- **installing a stair lift, additional handrails etc.**

If you feel your home requires any of these improvements you should contact the social work department at your local council. They will arrange for an Occupational Therapist to visit you in your home, and assess what equipment or adaptation you need.

The Occupational Therapist will then send a referral to the Association recommending what adaptations are necessary to enable you to remain in your home.

When the Association has received the referral from the Occupational Therapist, we will notify you, and arrange for one of our Technical Officers to visit you. The Technical Officer will identify exactly what work has to be instructed.

We will contact you when the contractor is ready to start work to make arrangements for access.
